
Paper "Fortune Teller" Game for "The Greatest Commandment" - Matthew 22:34-46

Directions for play:

- 1. Place your thumbs and index fingers into the four flaps. Your partner chooses one of the colors. Spell out that color while moving your thumbs and index fingers back and forth in alternating directions.
- 2. Your partner chooses one of the numbers. Count to that number while moving your thumbs and index fingers back and forth in alternating directions.
- 3. Your partner chooses another number. Open the large triangle and ask your partner to answer the question that's written underneath the flap.
