Jesus said that anything we do for even the least of his people, we also do for him. Use the list below to help you think of a ministry you can perform to help others. Choose an idea from this list, or use these ideas to think of other ministries:

- † Bake cookies for a shut-in and deliver them.
- † Write secret notes of encouragement to 10 people in your church and mail them.
- † Take a care package to someone in the hospital or a nursing home.
- † Do a job, such as mowing a lawn or cleaning someone's house, to raise money. Then use that money to help someone else; for example, buy school supplies or new clothes for another child.
- † Mow someone's yard for free.
- † Call 10 different people and tell them that Jesus loves them.
- † Set up a lemonade stand and give the lemonade away.
- † Be a servant for the day. Volunteer to help someone in your church and do whatever that person wants for one day.
- † Go through your closets. Send some of your clothes and toys to an orphanage or children's home in your area. (Ask your parents for permission first).
- † Send a care package to a college student or someone in the armed services who's away from home.
- † Volunteer to help out a mom with young kids by playing with her children at her house one afternoon.
- † Send a care package to a missionary family your church sponsors. Send packages of nonperishable items that don't weight very much, such as Jell-O, muffin mix, or pizza mix.
- † Volunteer to help out in the church nursery. Plan activities you can do with the little children, such as puppet shows or simple crafts.
