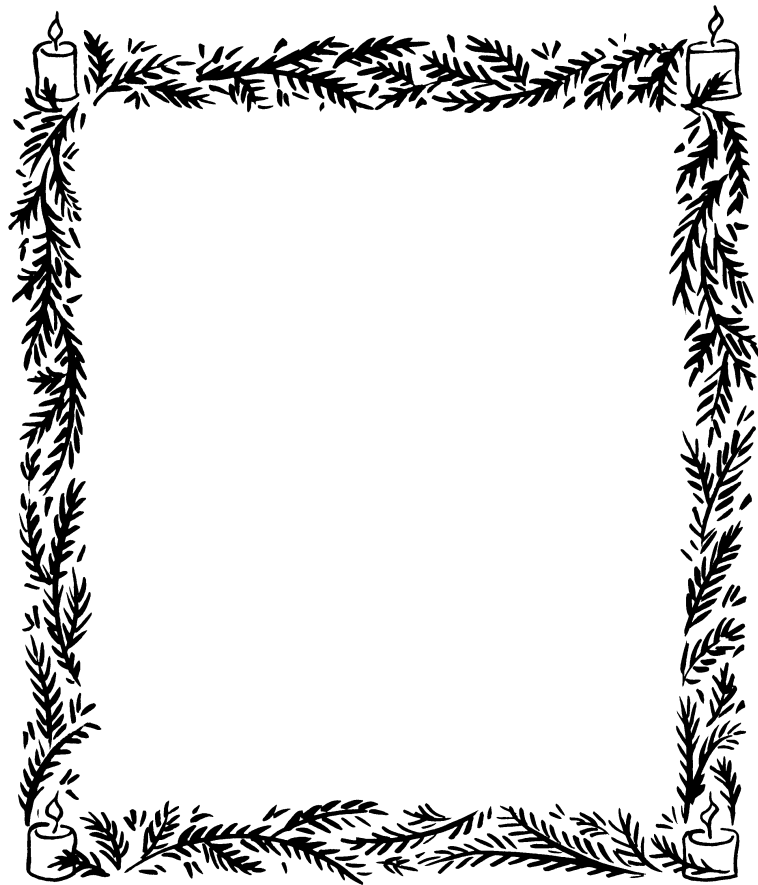
In the space above, draw a picture of how you and your family might celebrate Jesus' birthday for all 12 days of Christmas.
