Pentecost

Ask each other what you remember about:

- Apostles
- Mustard seed
- Mulberry tree
- Slave
- Command

Mustard seeds are tiny. Mulberry trees grow up to 60 feet (18 m).

Family Conversations

- 1 What are some things that start out small, then grow and grow?
- 2 Why do the disciples ask for more faith?
- 3 How can the faith you were given by God grow from the size of a mustard seed into an enormous plant?
- 4 Take turns sharing what God calls you to do.



Eye Spark

Look at the seeds of different plants—either actual seeds or pictures of seeds.



Ear Spark

Listen for God in the wind, moving through the leaves and branches of plants.

LIVE IT

For families to do together

Sing and play "Here we go 'round the mulberry bush" making up verses like "This is the way we praise our Lord, praise our Lord, praise our Lord..."

For younger kids

Take turns pretending to be seeds that grow. Start out as small as you can be on the floor. Your friend or family member can water you, read or sing a song to you, and shine light on you until you stand big and tall and reach to the sky!

For older kids

Do some research to learn about other small seeds that grow into enormous plants.
