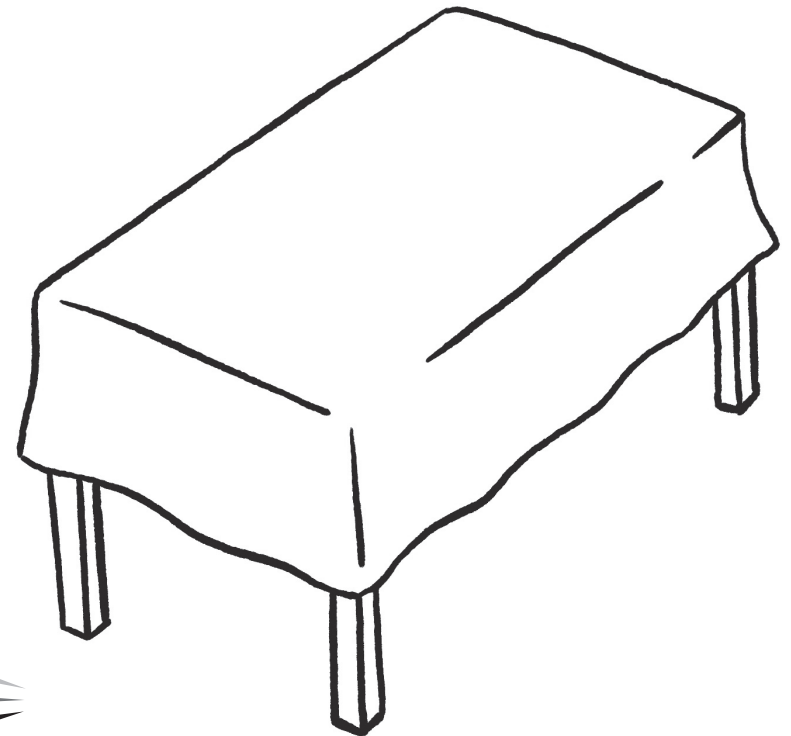

Maundy Thursday

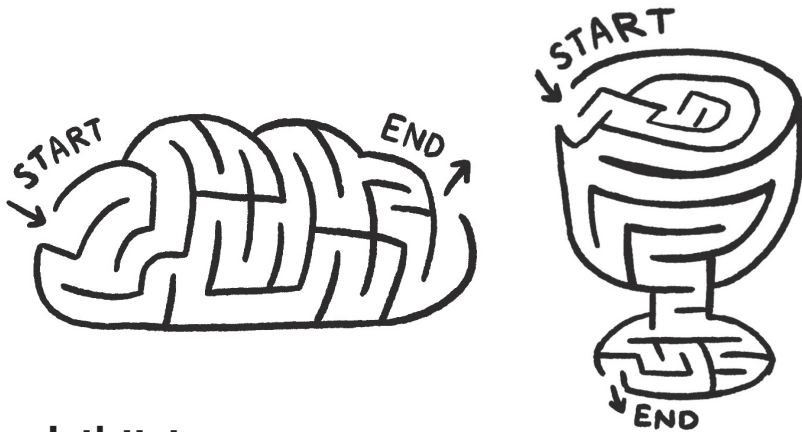
- Today is **Maundy Thursday**.
